Rules & Regulations

General Rules

- 1) For entries to be valid, Owners, Riders, Minor Guardians and Trainers must read the PRIZE LIST and agree to the LIABILITY WAIVER and RULES & REGULATIONS and acknowledge such agreement by providing signatures on the entry form
- 2) **All entries must be submitted no later than August 20, 2020 and include a valid credit card form or blank check made payable to Camwood Farm, LLC. Late entries will not be accepted**
- 3) Under Tennessee State law, each horse shall provide show office with current copy of Negative Coggins. Additionally, all animals coming from outside Tennessee MUST have a Health Certificate signed by licensed veterinarian within 14 days prior to arriving on the show grounds
- 4) Spectator viewing seating is limited, so it is recommended spectators bring their own chairs for sitting in the grass areas around the main arena
- 5) Access to the buildings is off limits to all individuals except staff, Camwood clients and participants renting a stall or paddock. The only exception access to the public restrooms in the first building, but only entry by the exterior doors is available and entry to the indoor arena for competitors
- 6) All signors and any of his/her representatives will accept the decision of the SHOW COMMITTEE as the final on any questions arising under the SHOW RULES
- 7) Vehicles located outside of designated parking areas will be asked to relocate
- 8) All Dogs must be on a leash when on the show grounds
- 9) A fee of \$50.00 will be charged for all returned checks

Liability Waiver

- 1) Signors are fully aware and fully understand that all horses are unpredictable and dangerous. They realize that placing their children, or themselves in a show and stables environment is creating a potentially hazardous situation
- 2) Signors understand that riding horses or ponies is a dangerous sport. They are aware that riders must expect the possibility of injury. They understand that injury or even death of people from equestrian accidents is possible
- 3) Signors realize that professional instruction cannot prevent serious injury or death from working around, handling, or riding horses and ponies. **Tennessee State Law, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 44, Chapter 20, Section 1: An equine professional is not liable for an injury to or death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities**
- 4) Signors realize that serious injury or death of their horse is possible when handled, trained, ridden or stalled.
- 5) Signors release Camwood Farm, LLC, its owners, trainers, and employees from all liability for damage to their property, injuries or death of their children, animals, or themselves
- 6) Signors give Camwood Farm, LLC, its owners, employees, and associates, their authorization to initiate emergency first aid and medical treatment for their children, animals, and themselves in case of an accident or injury. **Signors understand they are solely responsible for any expense associated with emergency medical, veterinary or farrier treatment.**
- 7) Signors agree to indemnify, save and hold harmless Camwood Farm, LLC and its principals and agents from and against any loss, liability, damage, attorneys' fees or costs that they may incur arising out of or in any way connected with either their presence or participation at Camwood Farm, LLC or any acts or omissions of Camwood Farm, LLC principals or agents.

Show Rules

- 1) Show Committee consists of Show Judges, Manager and Secretary
- 2) ASTM/SEI approved helmets must be worn at all times while mounted on the show grounds
- 3) Unless otherwise stated, three entries are required to form a complete class. Show Management reserves the right to cancel any class if entry number minimums have not been met, to combine same height divisions if necessary, or to change rings if necessary due to entries, time or conflict in schedules
- 4) A minimum of six ribbon placings will be offered in each class
- 5) Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded in all divisions consisting of 3 classes (hunter divisions must include an under saddle class)
- 6) Per MTHJA rules, martingales are not permitted in under saddle, equitation flat or flat phase of Medal classes. Additionally, unconventional hunter tack or equipment will only be permitted at the judge's discretion
- 7) The Camwood Farm Horse Shows are operated in accordance with the current rules of the MTHJA. To be eligible for year-end awards, the exhibitor, the owner and the horse or pony must be registered with the Association. MTHJA applications are available in the Camwood Show Office
- 8) Medical Staff will be on-site on the show days for emergency medical care. Tennessee Equine Hospital Veterinarian staff and Farrier, Jamie Boteler, will be on call for equine emergencies
- 9) Schooling area will have a minimum of a vertical and an oxer for warm-up
- 10) Courses will be posted next to respective show arenas a minimum of 30 minutes prior to ring start time
- 11) Schooling is available the day before the hunter show on Friday between the hours of 12:00pm to 6:30pm and the day of the jumper show between 7:30am to 9:00am in designated rings. Blue/Red Ribbon Warm-up available day of hunter show for \$20/warm-up

- 12) Classes will not be held for riders not ready and at the in-gate at their designated class time and may be subject to forfeiture of the class fee
- 13) Stalls (\$50/night) or Paddocks (\$25/day) are based on availability and first come, first serve basis. Available for purchase are Shavings for \$7/bag and Hay (timothy/orchard grass mix) for \$10/bale

Covid-19 Rules

- 1) You may not enter the competition grounds if you:
 - a. Exhibit COVID-19 symptoms (potential symptoms: Fever or chills, Cough, Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, Fatigue, Muscle or body aches, Headache, New loss of taste or smell, Sore throat, Congestion or runny nose, Nausea or vomiting, Diarrhea)
 - b. Have tested positive for COVID-19 within last two weeks
 - c. Have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the last two weeks
- 2) Any individual who was present on the competition grounds and tests positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of the conclusion of the competition, must immediately notify the Show Manager
- 3) All staff, officials, volunteers, service providers and participants (includes trainers, grooms, riders, minor rider legal guardians and horse owners) must wear face mask covering both nose and mouth at all times while on competition grounds in any setting where there is a possibility of being within six feet of any other individual, and when not mounted on a horse. A participant cannot be disqualified or penalized for wearing a facemask or face covering while competing.
- 4) Individuals must socially distance (or physically distance) on the competition grounds by staying at least 6 feet (about 2 arms' length) from any person who is not a member of their immediate household. Members of the same household are required to wear masks or face coverings when there is a possibility of being within six feet of any non-family member individuals
- 5) Wash hands or sanitize hands frequently
- 6) To minimize close contact with show staff, all ribbons and prizes will be available for pick-up in the horse show office at time of show bill check-out
- 7) Any individual not complying with all Covid-19 rules will be required to leave the competition grounds and if the individual is legal guardian of a minor, the minor will also be required to leave. If a minor is not complying, the minor will be required to leave with their legal guardian
